Travel, Parking & Drop-Off Instructions for Competitors

Overview

Please read this guide carefully before you travel. It explains how to get to Cubert, Holywell Bay, where to park, and how the drop-off system works throughout the championships.

The three key rules

- All competitor and spectator parking is at TREVORNICK HOLIDAY PARK. This is the main event parking area and where you should leave your vehicle for the day.
- Holywell itself (down by the beach) is DROP OFF AND TURNAROUND ONLY — there is no parking there. After dropping passengers or kit, vehicles must turn around at the marked turning point and return to Trevornick.
- The National Trust car park at Holywell must NEVER be used by event attendees, at any time during the week.

Getting between Trevornick and Holywell

A park-and-ride / minibus shuttle runs throughout each day between Trevornick Holiday Park and a turn-in circle at Holywell, so you don't need to walk the full distance or drive down yourself unless dropping off kit or passengers with limited mobility.

The three maps overleaf give the full picture: Map 1 shows the road directions into Cubert; Map 2 shows the route from the parking area down to the drop-off point; Map 3 gives a close-up of the drop-off and turning arrangements at Holywell itself.

Map 1 — Directions to Cubert, Holywell Bay, Cornwall

What to do

- Travelling north from Perranporth or Truro: turn LEFT off the A3075, signposted Cubert / Holywell Bay (point 1A).
- Travelling south from Newquay: turn RIGHT off the A3075, signposted Cubert / Holywell Bay (point 1B).
- Follow the Event Parking signs through the village — you will pass a marshal point (point 2) directing you into the Event Parking area at Trevornick Holiday Park.
- Do not follow sat-nav directions all the way to the beach — head for Event Parking first and use the shuttle from there.
- Allow extra time on race days, as the road through Cubert can be busy with event traffic.

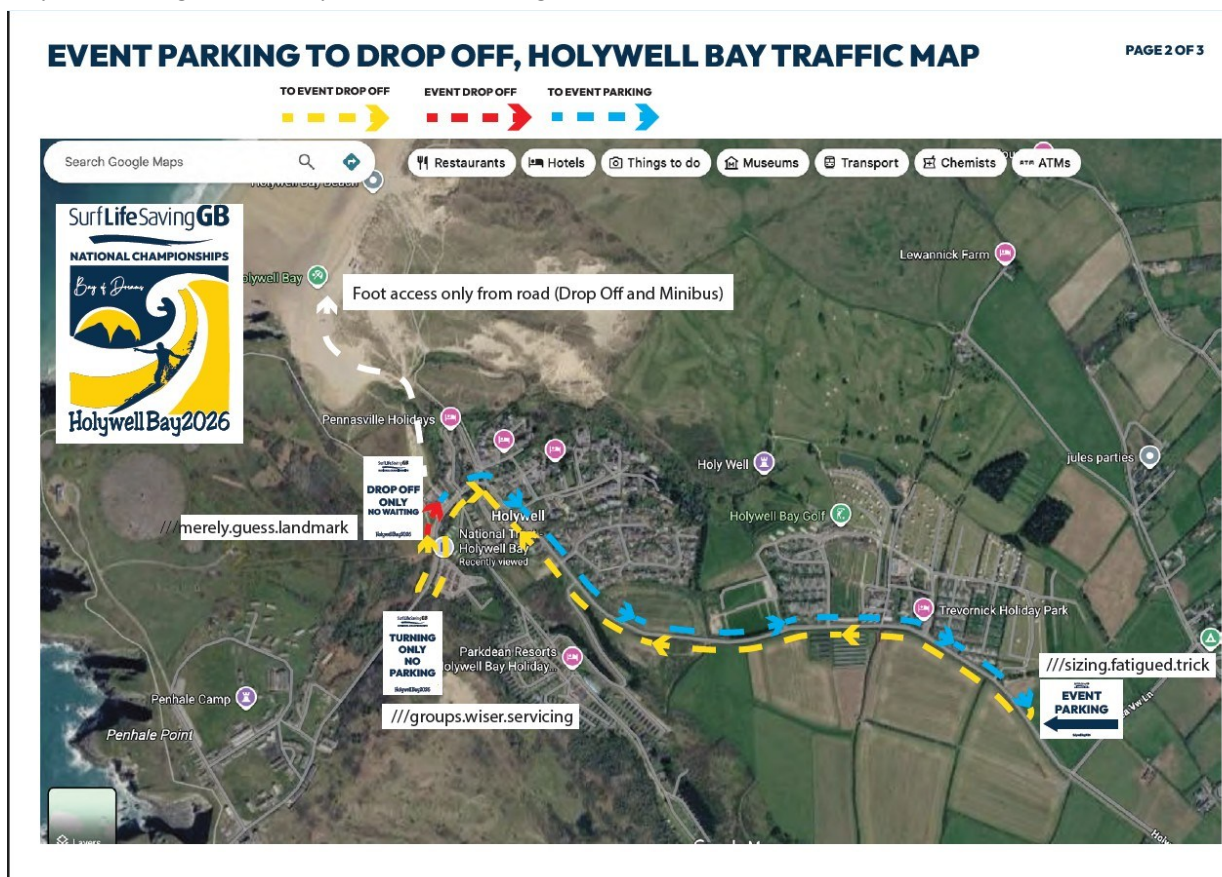


From Perranporth/Truro: turn left off the A3075. From Newquay: turn right off the A3075. Follow signs for Cubert / Event Parking.

Map 2 — Event Parking to Drop Off, Holywell Bay Traffic Map

What to do

- Park your vehicle at Trevornick Holiday Park (Event Parking, [///sizing.fatigued.trick](#)). This is the only parking area for the week — please do not park on verges or in the village.
- If you need to drop off kit or passengers, follow the BLUE route from Event Parking down to Holywell village.
- At the Drop Off Only – No Waiting point ([///merely.guess.landmark](#)) stop only briefly to unload — do not leave your vehicle unattended here.
- Continue to the Turning Only – No Parking point ([///groups.wiser.servicing](#)), turn around, and follow the YELLOW route straight back to Event Parking.
- Beach access from the drop-off point is on foot only — follow the marked footpath down to Holywell Bay.
- The National Trust car park (marked on the map) is NOT for event use at any time — please leave this free for regular National Trust visitors.
- If you don't need to drop anything off, use the free minibus/park-and-ride shuttle running between Trevornick and Holywell throughout the day instead of driving down.



Park at Trevornick Holiday Park. Follow the blue route down to the Drop Off Only point, then the yellow route back. Do not park at the National Trust car park.

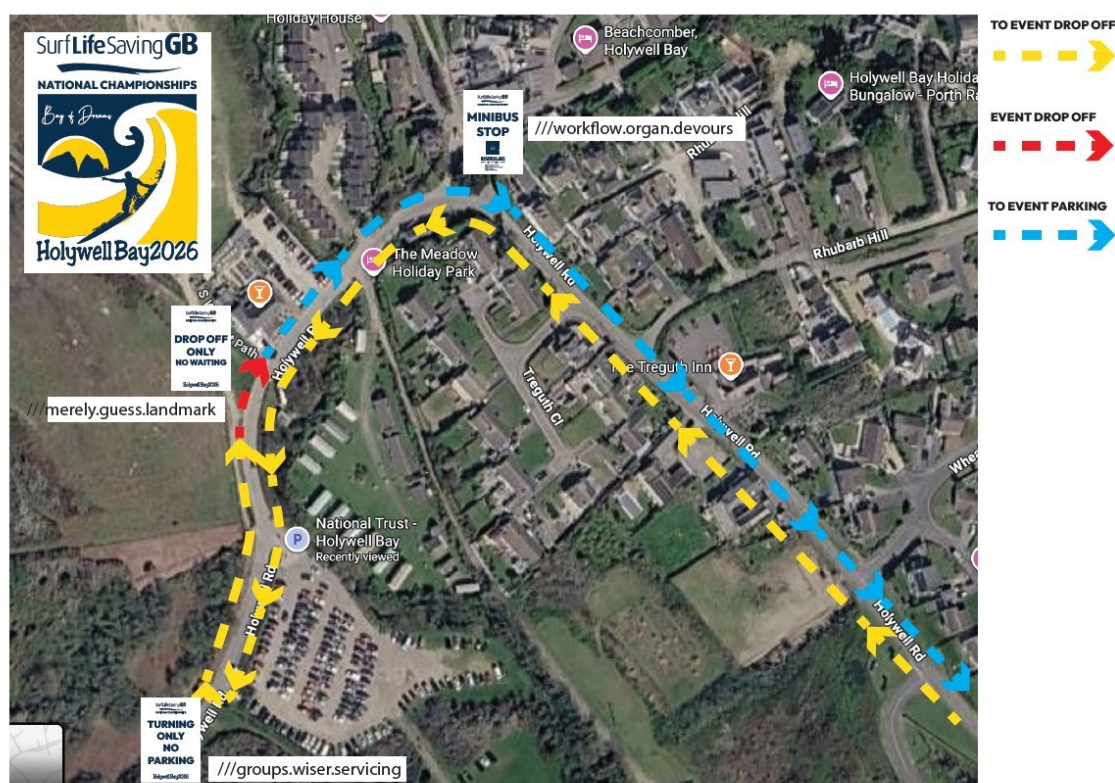
Map 3 — Holywell Bay Local Traffic Map (Detail)

What to do

- This map is a close-up of the final approach into Holywell village, for anyone dropping off kit or passengers.
- Follow Holywell Road down (BLUE route) past The Meadow Holiday Park and the Minibus Stop ([///workflow.organ.devours](http://workflow.organ.devours)) — this is also where you can pick up the park-and-ride shuttle if you'd rather not drive all the way down.
- Continue to the Drop Off Only – No Waiting point ([///merely.guess.landmark](http://merely.guess.landmark)), right by the National Trust Holywell Bay site — stop briefly to unload only.
- Turn around at the Turning Only – No Parking point ([///groups.wiser.servicing](http://groups.wiser.servicing)) and head back out along the same road (YELLOW route) towards Event Parking at Trevornick.
- Do not stop or park anywhere along Holywell Road itself — it is narrow and needs to stay clear for other competitors, emergency vehicles, and the shuttle.
- Remember: the National Trust car park here is off-limits to event traffic throughout the week.
